

**Progress Report**  
**INEB's Mindful Action: COVID-19 Emergency Relief Fund**

As of August 11, 2020, 19 proposals for organizations in 4 countries have received a total of 57,500 USD to conduct emergency relief activities through the International Network of Engaged Buddhists – INEB - Mindful Action: COVID-19 Emergency Relief Fund. The following tables include information about each country and the organizations that received funds. Since the organizations applied for funds at different times, they are all in various stages of implementing their relief activities. Please note that the actual direct beneficiaries are taken from reports and the estimated direct beneficiaries were taken from the proposals. Also, some funds were available for a Phase 2 which is included in the tables. Some organizations' activities have been delayed for various reasons including weather and receiving permission to access the targeted communities. We expect to prepare a final report with updated information in October.
